

Embroidered Candles by Mary Jane Allen
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Supplies:

Candles (tapers or pillars)
Teeny Holiday Designs (for tapers)
Seasonal Sprigs Designs (for pillars)
Water-soluble stabilizer
Tulle (same color as candles)
Embroidery threads
Craft glue (clear drying)



Hoop two layers of water-soluble stabilizer with a layer of tulle (fine netting) in between. For tapers, combine several Teeny Designs so they can all be embroidered in one hooping, with space between the designs so they can be cut out individually after embroidering. Embroider the designs.

For pillars, embroider one Seasonal Sprig design per hooping.

Gently pull away excess stabilizer and trim the netting close to the stitches. Apply glue to the back of the embroidery. For tapers, position each design about 3" or 3-1/2" from the bottom of the candle. For pillars, center the design. Press the designs firmly against the candles and allow to dry.

When burning candles, extinguish candles before the flame reaches the embroidery.
