

Handyman Briefs Project by Mary Jane Allen
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Supplies:

Pre-washed briefs
Teeny Tools Designs from Perfect Little Stitches
Disappearing ink pen
Lightweight cut-away stabilizer
Embroidery threads

Pre-wash and dry the briefs to pre-shrink.

Use a disappearing ink pen to mark the placement for the designs, along the centerline of the fly, 1-1/2" apart.

Hoop just the stabilizer. Turn the fly area inside-out so that you are embroidering only the outer layer. Pin to the stabilizer, placing the pins where the pressure foot will not hit them. Be careful not to stretch the fabric as you pin. You may be able to pin for two designs at once (as shown) or you may find it easier to pin for each design, using fresh stabilizer each time.

Position each design over the mark, except for the drill. This design will look better if you shift it slightly to the left (3 clicks on the Pfaff).

Be sure that the extra fabric is carefully held away from the area to be embroidered.

Re-hoop as necessary to embroider all designs. Trim the stabilizer close to the embroidery. Rinse out pen marks.

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
