

Pansy Lace Collar and T-Shirt Projects by Mary Jane Allen

Supplies:

Cotton camp shirt and plain white t-shirt

Assorted cotton embroidery threads

Matching bobbin thread (or embroidery thread wound on bobbins)

Water-soluble stabilizer

Pansy Single-Color and Bi-Color Lace designs from Perfect Little Stitches

For the camp shirt, stitch one left collar and one right collar in thread to match to shirt, using water-soluble stabilizer, with matching thread color in the bobbin. Thoroughly rinse out the stabilizer. Dry. Stitch to collar, as shown. If desired, fill in across the back of the collar with straight designs, overlapping the pieces (to allow the collar to shape, do not sew these pieces to each other where they overlap).

For the t-shirt, stitch the bi-color single pansy on water-soluble stabilizer, with matching thread color in the bobbin. Use different color combinations. Stitch at least 12 pansies. Rinse thoroughly. Dry. Arrange around the neckline so that colors are not repeated in adjacent pansies. Hand-stitch in place only at the top edge of each pansy. The neck opening needs to be able to stretch, so do not use a continuous line of stitches to attach the pansies.
