

Skeleton Sweatshirt Project by Mary Jane Allen  
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Supplies:

Black sweatshirt

Skeleton designs (Holiday) from Perfect Little Stitches

White and dark grey embroidery threads

Fusible tricot knit stabilizer and water-soluble stabilizer (to be used on top)

Pre-wash the sweatshirt. Fuse tricot knit stabilizer to the inside of the shirt with the stretch of the stabilizer going up and down. Mark a line just below where you want the skeletons' feet to go, all the way across the front of the shirt (hand baste with white thread or use chalk). Use this as a guideline for hooping. On this line, also mark where the center of each skeleton design should go, making them about 1-5/8" apart. With the Pfaff 120mm hoop, there is enough room to embroider two skeletons by either combining the designs in the software or by moving each skeleton either left or right within the hoop. Before embroidering, cover the entire area to be embroidered with a layer of water-soluble stabilizer. Do not remove excess stabilizer until all the skeletons have been embroidered. On the inside of the shirt, peel back the tricot knit stabilizer and trim near the design area. Wash out the water-soluble stabilizer.

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
