Supplies:

Purchased white long-sleeved t-shirt or sweatshirt
Trick-Or-Treater 1 & 2 Designs from Perfect Little Stitches
Teeny Halloween Designs from Perfect Little Stitches
Polymesh stabilizer
Assorted embroidery threads

Use your embroidery software to combine the designs as shown in the close-up photo. The combination shown is 4" x 7-1/2". If that is too large for your hoop, create two designs (cat, pirate, teeny bat, teeny cat and witch, skeleton) and multi-hoop.

Hoop the polymesh stabilizer. Try on the shirt to decide where you want to stitch the design. Pin that part of the shirt to the stabilizer, using several pins along each side of the hoop (outside the embroidery field!). Embroider the design. Unpin. Trim the stabilizer as close to the design as practical.
